# Synopsis

Based on Giacomo Puccini's opera *La Bohème*, *Rent* was written by American composer and playwright Jonathan Larson, a brilliant creative mind who unfortunately did not live to see the success his musical would become.

The show begins on Christmas Eve in New York's East Village, and follows a year in the life of a group of creative friends fighting to overcome poverty, amongst other things. Many of these characters are also HIV positive, and throughout the show must come to terms with their mortality, sexuality and vices.

Love and its boundaries are explored through the couples of Roger and Mimi, Collins and Angel, and Maureen and Joanne, as well as the group and community in how they support each other. Filmmaker Mark captures the pivotal points in their lives across this year, reminding everyone of the importance of friendship, love, and community support in making life something worth living. At its heart, *Rent* is not about 'living with', it's about living; treasuring each moment as if it were your last, and loving others as if this were your only chance.

## NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR: Kate Douglas

Despite originally pitchilling Rent when I applied for the role of director back in 2015, I never imagined this overly optimistic idea could actually come to be.

Rent's unique ability to provoke critique of common ideologies and highlight the grey matter of society was undoubtedly the basis of my selection. 
## STAGE MANAGER: Sidney Millar


## ASSISTANT DIRECTOR: Lydia Bell


## NOTE FROM THE PRODUCER: Beth Lamb

### Roger Davis – Caleb Ballinger




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### Mimi Marquez – Holly Piney


### Joanne Jefferson – Kelsey Rettino

### Benjamin Coffin III – Darius Hubbard




Darius didn't choose the Benny life, the Benny life chose Darius!
